Featured Speaker

Dr. John Ed Mathison

REV. DR. JOHN ED MATHISON retired in June 2008 after serving 36 years as senior minister of Frazer Memorial United Methodist Church in Montgomery Alabama. At his retirement, Frazer had eight Sunday morning worship services at the Atlanta Highway campus—3 traditional, 3 contemporary, 1 Hispanic and 1 Chinese. Frazer televised its worship services nationwide each week with INSP network, reaching about 40 million homes. Under his leadership, Frazer grew from 400 members to 9,000 and had the largest Sunday School attendance for United Methodist churches in America.

The son of a United Methodist minister, John Ed graduated from Opelika High School and Young Harris Junior College. He holds a Bachelor's degree from Huntingdon College, a Bachelor of Divinity degree from Candler School of Theology, a Master's degree from Princeton Seminary, and the Doctor of Ministry Degree from Candler School of Theology. He also has honorary doctorate degrees from Asbury Seminary, Huntingdon College and Birmingham Southern College.

He and his wife, Lynn, have three daughters and one son.
