REV. DR. CONSTANCE CHERRY is Professor of Worship and Pastoral Ministry at Indiana Wesleyan University where she directs three distinct Christian worship majors: Christian Worship, Worship Arts, and Worship Ministry. She is also a founding faculty member of The Robert E. Webber Institute for Worship Studies.

Constance is an experienced worship leader, musician, and pastor, having served in local church ministry for many years. She is also a published author and composer. Her first book, *The Worship Architect: A Blueprint for Designing Culturally Relevant and Biblically Faithful Services* is used as a required text at more than 125 institutions of higher education and will soon appear in its fourth language.
