







Reimagine Charity (Morning)

The Reimagine Charity Seminar is an introduction to the frameworks for understanding why certain efforts to address poverty are ineffective or at times harmful. The seminar introduces groups to the basic concepts of toxic and responsible charity. It is an interactive event that reveals why traditional charity paradigms are not working and casts a vision on a better way. By looking at real life examples, participating in thought-provoking exercises, and being exposed to compelling teaching, participants come away ready to chart a new course for a more responsible engagement with the materially poor.
