TODAY'S CHURCH LEADERS ARE USING COACHING TO TRANSFORM MINISTRY

Leadership Coaching Circles are designed to equip and encourage pastors as they lead their congregations through the challenging transitions that result in local church revitalization, meaningful new ministries, and Kingdom growth.

Leadership Coaching Circles will enable participating pastors to:

- Develop valuable coaching skills
- Increase worship attendance by at least 10%
- Increase financial giving by at least 5%
- Implement an effective process for growing mature disciples
- Empower ministry leaders with a team approach
- Envision and successfully launch new ministry initiatives
- Learn best practices and strategic insights for healthy growth

Leadership Coaching Circles include these elements:

- Circles of up to 10 clergy meet via videoconferencing for group coaching twice per month, for eight months. Each of these virtual sessions last approximately 75 minutes.
- Participants attend a one-day 'Introduction to Leadership Coaching' training event to be held at the East Ohio Conference Center in September, 2017.
- Participants receive on-going Coaching Skills Training and Leadership Coaching by Rick Oaks, a UMC pastor, EOC Coaching Network Facilitator, and a member of the International Coach Federation, who has been coaching church leadership teams and pastors since 2006.
- Participants also receive coaching by another participant in twice-a-month peer-coaching calls.
- The cost for all of this is \$300 per person. The EOC will underwrite half of the total cost, leaving a **total balance of \$150 for each participant.**

Added Bonus

Participation in a Leadership Coaching Circle will help provide the coaching hours needed for individuals to become an East Ohio Conference Recommended Coach.

The next East Ohio Leadership Coaching Circle will begin in September 2017.
