From Upper Sandusky: 2 hrs. 15 min.
Take 30 E. to OH 250. Follow to 77 S. to exit 46B, and follow directions above.

He now provides training to churches on various aspects of planning, including emergency procedures for fire, severe weather, and active shooter situations. He has 29 years of law enforcement experience, 33 years in the Ohio National Guard, and recently retired from 24 years with the Ohio State Highway Patrol, and currently serves as a lieutenant with the Columbus State Community College Police Department.

Mike Williams is the EOC Disaster Response Coordinator & the Disaster Comm. Chr. He is an active ERT with UMCOR. He will share best practices of UMCOR's Connecting Neighbor program which helps us to be equipped and prepared as individuals and churches for emergencies in our church and especially in our community. He has 30+ years in the insurance industry.

Dale Martin helps lead the *Celebrate Recovery* ministry held at Christ Cambridge UMC. *Celebrate Recovery* helps people with Hurts, Habits, and Hang-ups. They meet weekly to teach and uplift, using Jesus Christ as their higher power. They also offer a Christ-based 12 step program for teens and children, called *Salvation Place*, to support the entire family.

Dave Pennington is a Certified Lay Minister, who for the last 12 years has engaged incarcerated and addicted inmates in Licking County. His passion is in the field of jail and prison ministry.

Other Speakers include: addiction services, a heroin addict in recovery, and law enforcement.
