The adult curriculum uses the image of home to explore how living in close proximity to the kin-dom is like making a home with God. Participants are invited to develop practices for building healthy, welcoming communities as a result of being anchored in the abiding love of God.

**Youth** — Cultivating Symbiosis: The Nature of God's Kin-dom by Nica Sy In Creation, we see the power of symbiosis, or interdependent relationship. The youth curriculum explores the idea of symbiosis between our relation- ships with one another and our relationship with God. By drawing closer to one another and our world, we draw closer to the kin-dom.
